1. This writ petition is filed on behalf of the Petitioners under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking the following reliefs:-

“a) issue a writ of mandamus or any other suitable writ, order or direction to respondent to re-activate login credentials of petitioner institute enabling it to login & submit its online application-Standard Inspection Form (SIP) with supporting documents & processing fee for extension of approval of its existing D.Pharm course for academic session 2026-27;

b) pass any such other orders/directions as this Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.”

2. Mr. Amitesh Kumar, learned counsel for the Petitioners submits that part of the relief sought in the writ petition has been granted inasmuch as PCI has reactivated its portal and while Petitioner No.1 Institute has been able to login, but is unable to upload the data due to technical glitches in respect of its online application–Standard Inspection Form along with supporting documents.



3. Issue notice.
4. Mr. Ajay Kumar, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the Respondent and on instructions submits that portal of PCI will be kept active till 19.12.2025 to enable the Petitioner No.1 to upload the necessary data.
5. In light of the stand taken by PCI, which the Court appreciates, no further order is required to be passed in this writ petition and the same is accordingly disposed of.
