3. This writ petition is filed on behalf of the Petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking the following reliefs:-

“A. To issue a writ of Mandamus or any other similar writ to the Respondent directing them to restore the possession of the Petitioner on the land situated in Khasra No.69/2, Village Ghonda Chauhar Khadar, Delhi.

B. To issue a writ of mandamus or any other similar writ to the Respondent directing them to convert the lease of the Petitioner from temporary lease to permanent lease on the land situated in Khasra No.69/2, Village Ghonda Chauhar Khadar, Delhi in view of the previous



precedents as exercised by the Respondent on its discretion by levying the necessary charges and to direct the Respondent to accept lease charges from the Petitioner”

4. After canvassing some arguments, learned Senior Counsel for the Petitioner, on instructions from the counsel on record who is in turn instructed by the Petitioner, seeks to withdraw this writ petition unconditionally.
5. Writ petition along with the pending application is disposed of as withdrawn.
