1. This is a petition filed under Section 29A(4) and (5) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 seeking extension of mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal by a period of 12 months for concluding the arbitral proceedings and passing the final award.
2. It is stated that the issue before the Arbitrator are complicated and technical in nature and hence the delay.
