1. The petition has been filed with following prayers:-

“a. Quash and set aside the impugned order dated 08.05.2024 and the subsequent order dated 10.07.2024 qua the Petitioner herein passed by the Hon’ble NCDRC in Execution Application No. 114 of 2019 titled as ‘*Nirmala Sharma & Anr. v. AEZ Infratech Pvt. Ltd. & Ors*’, and

b. Quash and set aside the show cause notice issued to the Petitioner by the Hon’ble NCDRC in Execution Application No. 114 of 2019 titled as ‘*Nirmala Sharma & Anr. v. AEZ Infratech Pvt. Ltd. & Ors*’.”

2. However, the limited prayer pressed before this Court is for the grant



of exemption from physical appearance before National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission [“NCDRC”] on each date.

3. Learned counsel submits that in CM (M) 4052/2024, this Court issued directions to NCDRC not to insist for physical presence of the other directors except when it is required.

4. In view of the limited request being pressed, the petition is disposed of with directions that NCDRC shall not insist for physical presence of the petitioner except when so required and on other occasions, the petitioner may be permitted to appear through video conferencing.
