ORDER

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1. This is a petition filed under Section 29A(5) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 seeking extension of the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal by a further period of 1 year for making and publishing the final Award.
2. It is stated that the position of Special Secretary remained vacant and there was no Arbitrator available to conduct the pending proceedings and hence, the delay.
3. For the said reasons, issue notice to the respondents.
