1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application stands disposed of.

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3. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner, a senior citizen aged about 76 years being aggrieved by the delay in taking up the petitioner's eviction application filed under Rule 22(3) of the Delhi Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Rules, 2009 for consideration.
4. It is submitted that great hardship is being caused to the petitioner as a result of the non-consideration of the aforesaid application by the concerned authority.
5. Considering the averments made in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent no.3/ SDM, New Delhi Jamnagar House to bestow urgent consideration to the aforesaid application



of the petitioner and make an endeavour to dispose of the same as expeditiously as possible, and preferably within a period of three months from today.

6. Let hearings be scheduled at short intervals so as to adhere to the above time limit, and also in line with the prescription under Rule 22(3) of the Delhi Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Rules, 2009.

7. The above directions are issued in the peculiar facts and circumstances of the present case, as highlighted in the petition.

8. The petition is disposed of in the above terms.
