1. By way of the present application, the petitioners/applicants pray for the disposal of the present writ petition in terms of the judgement dated 25.07.2011 of this Court in W.P.(C) No. 1595/2011, titled **DSSSB & Anr v. Kapil Kumar & Ors.**
2. The aforesaid judgment was, however, challenged before the Supreme Court, registered as CA No. 10081/2014, titled **Kapil Kumar v. DSSSB**, and the same was disposed of in terms of the judgment of the Supreme Court in **Bir Singh v. Delhi Jal Board**, (2018) 10 SCC 312.
