1. The suit has already been disposed of *vide* judgment and decree dated 23.01.2025, and is taken up on I.A. 10708/2025, an application filed on behalf of defendant nos.3 and 4, seeking for the return of the original documents, which were produced during the pendency of the trial.
2. Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the parties.
3. The instant application is strongly opposed by Mr. Rajat Manchanda, learned counsel for the plaintiffs, who contends that if the documents are allowed to be handed over to the applicant, the applicant may create third party rights or even dispose of the property. He also contends that an appeal is pending before the Division Bench of this Court.
