1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. The present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeks following prayers:-

“a) Issue writ of certiorari and other writ, order or direction in the nature of certiorari for quashing the suspension dt. 08.01.13 of the Petitioner by the Respondent No. 2;

b) Issue a writ of mandamus or any other writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus directing the Respondent No. 1 MYAS to ensure the removal of Respondent No. 3 as Honorary Secretary of Respondent No. 2 NSF on the grounds of violation of Rule 15 of the CCS (Conduct) Rules, 1964 failing which Respondent No. 1 MYAS must derecognize Respondent No. 2 NSC forthwith;

c) Issue a writ of mandamus or any other writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus directing fresh elections for the post of Honorary Secretary of Respondent No. 2 NSF under the supervision, control & aegis of Respondent No. 1 within 30 days from the date of removal of Respondent No. 3;

d) And pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem



fit in the facts and circumstances of the case;”

3. None appears on behalf of the petitioner today.
4. There has been no appearance on behalf of the petitioner for the last three dates of hearing, *i.e.*, 06.03.2025, 03.04.2025 and 13.08.2025.
5. Report with regard to notice issued for default in appearance reflects that the same was unserved on account of premises were found locked.
