1. This hearing has been conducted through hybrid mode.
2. The present appeal has been filed by the Appellant – *Raj Kumar @ Rajman*, under Section 374(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, assailing the Judgment of conviction dated 26th June 2014 and the order on sentence dated 01st July, 2014, passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge - 01, Patiala House Courts, New Delhi, in Sessions Case No. 110/2013 arising out of FIR bearing No. 94/2013 of Police Station Chankya Puri.
3. The Appellant was convicted for the offence punishable under Section 354-B IPC.
4. It is stated that the Appellant was released from jail on 16th January 2016 after completing the sentence awarded to him.



5. Learned counsel for the Appellant, on instructions from the Appellant, submits that since the Appellant has already undergone the complete sentence awarded to him, he does not wish to press the present appeal, as the same has become infructuous.

7. The Trial Court Record (*TCR*) and the Nominal Roll have been perused.
