2. The present petition under Sections 397 and 401 read with Section 482 of the CrPC seeks the following prayers: -

“i. Allow the present revision petition of the petitioners, thereby set-aside/quash the impugned Order dated 11.08.2016, passed by the Ld. Trial Court of Ms. Bimla Kumari, A.SJ., Special Fast Track Court, North District, Rohini, Delhi, in case nR No. 123/2013, P.S. K.S. Katju Marg, Delhi, under Section 376/511/506/498-A/354/313/406/323/34 IPC, thereby framed the charges against the petitioners for the offences punishable under Section 498A/406/34 IPC and pass orders for discharging the petitioners; and
