1. The present application has been moved by Union of India with the prayer that the present contempt petition may be disposed of, in view of the fact that the matter is pending adjudication before the Hon'ble Supreme Court and stay has been granted.
2. During course of the arguments, it was also submitted that as per the outcome of the above said *Special Leave Petition* i.e. SLP (C) Diary No. 6040/2020, the petitioner can always either revive the present contempt petition or can file a petition afresh but there is no point in keeping the contempt pending.
3. Learned counsel for petitioner does admit the above said factual matrix and submits that the proceedings are lying stayed. He, therefore, prays that, without prejudice to his rights and contentions, the petitioner does not press

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the present contempt petition.

4. He, however, seeks liberty to revive the present contempt petition by moving appropriate application or to file contempt petition afresh as per the outcome of the above said SLP.
5. Petition stands disposed of in aforesaid terms.
6. Liberty, as prayed, is granted.
