1. Heard Sri Vinod Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioners as well as Sri Dev Rishi Kumar, learned counsel for the respondents.

2. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is working on the post of constable in Railway Protection Force and seeks fixation of his salary in the light of Government Order dated 26.08.1977 and 08.05.1983.

3. It has been submitted that grievance of petitioner was raised up to the level of Railway Board, but the matter was remitted back with noting that the issue can be decided by the competent authority itself.

4. Grievance of the petitioner is that till date salary of petitioner has not been fixed, due to which he is receiving lesser salary and accordingly, petitioner confines his prayer for suitable direction to respondent no. 4/competent authority to consider and decide petitioner's representation dated 14.11.2024 (annexed as Annexure 7 to the writ petition), expeditiously.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents has no objection in case suitable directions are issued to respondent no. 4 / competent authority to consider and decide petitioner's representation.

6. In view of above, present writ petition is **disposed of** with direction to respondent no. 4 /competent authority to proceed to consider and decide petitioner's representation dated 14.11.2024 (annexed as Annexure 7 to the writ petition), expeditiously, say within six weeks from the date of production of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law by means of reasoned and speaking order and communicate the decision to the petitioner.
