Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, Shri S.B.Pandey, learned Deputy Solicitor General of India assisted by Shri Varun Pandey, learned counsel for the respondent no.1 to 3 and Ms. Ruby Chaudhary, Advocate, who has filed Vakalatnama on behalf of respondent nos. 4 and 5, which is taken on record.
