1. Heard learned counsel for petitioner and Mr.S.B. Pandey, learned Deputy Solicitor General of India assisted by Mr.Anand Dwivedi, learned counsel for opposite parties.

2. Although petition has been filed challenging the punishment order dated 11.11.2024 and the appellate order dated 14.02.2025, learned counsel for petitioner, on the basis of instructions, submits that revision against the aforesaid orders is already pending before opposite party No.1 which may be directed to be decided.

In view of aforesaid submissions, opposite party No.1, i.e., Union of India through the Director General, Railway Protection Force, Northern Railway, Rail Bhawan, New Delhi - 110 001, is directed to decide revision preferred by the petitioner, expeditiously, within a period of eight weeks from the date a certified copy of this order is served upon the authority concerned.
