HON'BLE MANISH MATHUR, J.

1. Heard learned counsel for petitioners and learned State Counsel appearing on behalf of the opposite parties.
2. Present petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India has been filed seeking a direction to opposite parties to grant benefit of modified assured career progression financial upgradation of Grade Pays Rs.4600/- and 4800/- respectively with all consequential benefits. Further prayer has been made to opposite parties to recompute their last pay drawn on notional basis and refix pension, gratuity and commutation accordingly. Petitioners have also sought interest on the arrears.
3. Since considering petitioners' grievance would entail factual aspects, liberty is granted to petitioners to file fresh individual representation(s) before opposite party no.4 i.e. the Senior Divisional Personnel Officer, North Eastern Railways, Lucknow or any other competent authority. In case such representations are filed, the same are required to be decided by authority concerned expeditiously by a reasoned and speaking order within a period of eight weeks from receipt of representation(s) of petitioners along with a certified copy of this order.
4. With aforesaid direction, the petition stands finally **disposed of**.
