APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in N.D.P.S. case No. 43 of
2025, D.R.I. Case No. 12 of 2024-25 registered for the offence
punishable under Sections-8(c), 20, 25, 27, of N.D.P.S. Act.

3. The petitioner is alleged to be carrying Cocaine in
two packets kept in a trolley bag containing 4.450 kg. and 4.2 kg
of Cocaine respectively was recovered which was worth Rs.
42,00,000,00/- (Rs. Forty two crores.)

4. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner
that the petitioner is in custody since 14-11-2024 and as such, he
has remained in custody for around one and a half years.

5. Learned APP has opposed the prayer for bail.



6. Considering the recovery of Cocaine in commercial quantity, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner and accordingly, it is *rejected*.

7. However, learned trial court is directed to conclude the trial of the petitioner as early as possible, preferably, within a period of six months.
