2. Application is filed for restoration of CWJC No. 17784 of 2016, which stood dismissed on account of non-prosecution vide order dated 18.08.2023 passed by this Court.

3. Learned Advocate for the State submitted that on account of repeated non appearance of the petitioners, the writ petition stood dismissed on account of non-prosecution.

4. Learned Advocate for the petitioner submits that



the cause of action still survives and if the writ petition is not restored, irreparable injury shall be caused to the petitioner.
