3 06-04-2026 Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner and learned APP appearing on behalf of the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case
registered for the offence punishable under Sections 137, 96 and
3(5) of the B.N.S..

3. As per prosecution case, it is alleged that on
23.05.2025, this petitioner, with the help of other F.I.R. named
accused persons, kidnapped minor granddaughter of informant.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel appearing on
behalf of the petitioner that petitioner is quite innocent and has
committed no offence. Allegations levelled against this



petitioner are false and concocted. During investigation, the victim returned and in her statement recorded under Section 183 of the B.N.S.S., she denied the *factum* of kidnapping and has categorically stated that she was in love with this petitioner for the last three years and out of her own sweet will, had gone with this petitioner and both of them had solemnized marriage. The learned trial court has assessed the age of victim as 18 years. Petitioner claims clean antecedents.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, statement of the victim recorded under Sections 183 of the B.N.S.S. and clean antecedents of the petitioner, the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is allowed.

7. Accordingly, in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of eight weeks from today, let the above named petitioner be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M., Biraul, Darbhanga in connection with Kusheshwar Asthan P.S. Case No. 147 of 2025, subject to condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of



the B.N.S.S..
