2. This is second anticipatory bail petition. Earlier the petition, filed for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of petitioners, stood dismissed on *merit*, vide order dated 07.04.2023 passed in Cr.Misc. No. 74314 of 2022.

3. The present petition does not reveal any change of circumstance or new ground.

4. In view of the fact that no fresh ground has been pressed for consideration of pre-arrest bail as well as in view of the recent judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case



of *G.R. Ananda Babu Vs. State of Tamil Nadu and Anr.*,
reported in *2021 SCC Online SC 176*, the second anticipatory
bail petition is not maintainable. It is, accordingly, dismissed.
