ORAL ORDER

2 30-01-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Purnea Sadar P.S. Case No. 425/2025 instituted for the
offences under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise
Act.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that total 351 litres
of liquor was recovered from pick-up vehicle.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the
petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case.
Learned counsel further submitted that petitioner is not the
owner of the alleged vehicle. The petitioner has got no concern
with the alleged recovery of liquor. The other co-accused person



has already been granted bail by this court vide order dated 27.11.2025 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 81425/2025. Learned counsel, therefore, submitted that prima-facie, no case is made out against the petitioner. The petitioner has four criminal antecedents out of which only one case is related to Excise Act. There is no compliance of Section 103 of the Bharatiya Nagarika Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Purnea Sadar P.S. Case No. 425/2025, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarika Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
