2 19-01-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Chebra P.S. Case No. 5 of 2025 instituted for the offences
under Sections 30(a), 32, 41(1) of the Bihar Prohibition and
Excise Act and Sections 336(3), 340(2), 338 of the Bharatiya
Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that total 564 litres
of liquor was recovered from car.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the
petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case.
Learned counsel further submitted that petitioner is neither the
owner nor the driver of the vehicle. The petitioner has got no



concern with the alleged recovery of liquor. Learned counsel, therefore, submitted that, prima-facie, no case is made out against the petitioner. The petitioner has one criminal antecedent. There is no compliance of Section 103 of the Bharatiya Nagarika Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Chebra P.S. Case No. 5 of 2025, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarika Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
