ORAL ORDER

2 19-01-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned APP
for the State.

2. The petitioners seek bail in connection with
Agamkuan PS Case No. 925 of 2025 instituted for the offences
under Sections 30(a) & 32 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise
Act.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that 407.820 liters
foreign liquor was recovered from two motorcycles.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the
petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the
present case. No incriminating material has been recovered from
the conscious possession of the petitioners. The petitioners have



got no concern with the alleged recovery of liquor. It is submitted that petitioners are not the owner of the motorcycles in question and they have no concern with the same. The petitioners are in custody since 13.12.2025 and petitioner No.1 bears one criminal antecedent/s, whereas petitioner No.2 bears no criminal antecedent/s. There is no compliance of Section 103 of the BNSS, 2023.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioners.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and the period of custody undergone by the petitioners, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners.

7. Let the petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.15,000/- (Fifteen thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Agamkuan PS Case No. 925 of 2025.
