2 04-02-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, informant and the State.

2. Petitioners apprehend arrest in Mali P. S. Case No. 23 of 2021 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 149, 341, 323, 307, 380, 325, 427, 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the informant submits that petitioners have been declared absconder and process of Section 82 of the Cr.P.C. has been initiated against them on 04.11.2025 to ensure their appearance in the Court as such petitioners are not entitled to the relief of anticipatory bail (*Lavesh v. State (NCT of Delhi) (2012) 8 SCC 730, State of*



MP v. Pradeep Sharma (2014) 2 SCC 17, Prem Shankar Prasad v. State of Bihar 2021 SCC OnLine SC 955).

4. Considering the aforesaid development, petition for pre-arrest bail of petitioners is dismissed as not maintainable.
