2 19-02-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 8, 20(b)(ii)(C), 23(C), 25, 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act.

3. As per prosecution case, 5.580 kg Ganja was recovered from the seized motorcycle. Co-accused Dharmendra Rai was apprehended on the spot who disclosed the name of this petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no incriminating material has been recovered from conscious possession of the petitioner and he has been made accused only on the basis of confessional statement of the apprehended co-accused. Petitioner is neither driver nor owner of the vehicle in question. Petitioner has got no concern with the alleged



recovery and claims clean antecedent.

5. Considering the nature of accusation and clean antecedent, this anticipatory bail is allowed and it is ordered that let the above named petitioner in the event of his arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of eight weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Exclusive Special Judge, Court No. I, NDPS East Champaran, Motihari in connection with Lakhaura P. S. Case No. 262 of 2025, subject to condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita.
