3 03-04-2026 The present petition has been filed for restoration of a petition bearing MJC No. 522 of 2025, which has stood dismissed for default on account of non-compliance of the peremptory order dated 12.12.2025.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that due to personal difficulty, the defects could not be removed within time, as pointed out by the registry, hence a sympathetic view be taken and the aforesaid petition be restored to its original file.

3. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the averments made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, I deem it fit and proper to direct for restoration of



the aforesaid petition bearing MJC No. 522 of 2025 to its original file, however subject to removal of the defects, as pointed out by the registry, within a period of four weeks from today.
