Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Dinara
PS Case No.363 of 2025 dated 31.07.2025, instituted for the
offence punishable under Sections 191(2), 191(3), 190, 221,
132, 109 of the *Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita*, 2023, and Section 27
of the Arms Act.

3. The allegation against the petitioner is that he and
other accused persons obstructed the government officials, who
were deputed for maintaining law and order on account of land
dispute between the petitioner and the villagers of the petitioner,
from discharging their official duty. There is also allegation of
opening fire from the house of the petitioner. Further, there was



firing from both sides, but no one has sustained any injury.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the FIR has been lodged against 43 named accused persons including the petitioner and 200 unknown persons. It is further submitted that the petitioner is the landlord of the village and the members of the rival group are trying to grab the land of the petitioner on the pretext of settlement made by the ex-landlord. Learned counsel further submits that for the same occurrence, the District Administration has lodged three cases against the accused persons for creating law and order problem. Learned counsel further submitted that the petitioner is accused in only one case lodged by the Revenue Officer, Dinara, i.e., the present one and the members of the rival group have been made accused in all three cases. There is case and counter case between the parties. Earlier, the petitioner lodged Dinara PS Case No.154 of 2025 against the members of the rival group for preventing him from harvesting the crops. Lastly, it is submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 27.08.2025 having two criminal cases against him. Charge-sheet has already been submitted in this case.

5. Learned APP has opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Having considered the facts and circumstances of



the case and submissions of learned counsel for the parties, let the petitioner be released on bail upon furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the ACJM, Bikramganj, Rohtas, in Dinara PS Case No.363 of 2025.

7. The application stands allowed.
