2 03-02-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State .

2. Petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 126 (2), 115 (2), 117 (2), 118 (2), 109, 118 (1) , 303 (2), 351 (2), 4 (3) , 352 and 3 (5) of BNS.

3 . As per F.I.R., on 21.09.2025 , all the named accused persons including these petitioners assaulted nephew of informant, as a result of which he sustained injuries. It is further alleged that accused persons took away gold tabiz from his neck



and also threatened with dire consequences.

4. It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that allegation of assault is general and omnibus against these petitioners. As per F.I.R. total 4 persons are alleged to have assaulted nephew of informant but there are only 2 injuries. Rest of the allegations are ornamental in nature to make the case grave . Petitioners claim clean antecedent.

5 . Learned counsel for the State oppose the bail petition .

6 Considering the aforesaid facts, clean antecedent of these petitioners and other circumstances of the case , in the event of arrest or surrender within eight weeks from today, let the petitioners, as named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned J M 1st Nawada in connection with Parnadabar P.S. Case No. 248 of 2025 , subject to the conditions laid down under section 482 (2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS) , 2023 .
