petitioner and Mr. Parmanand Prasad, learned APP for the

State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for bail in connection
with Shahpur P.S. Case No. 195 of 2025 registered for the
offence punishable under Sections 191(2), 191(3), 126(2),
115(2), 109, 103(1), 352, 351(2) of the B.N.S., 2023.

3. The case of the prosecution in short is that the
petitioner, along with others being armed with weapons, arrived
and the petitioner ordered to assault, and on his order, other
accused persons assaulted the father of the informant, who
succumbed to the injuries.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has



committed no offence. He has been falsely implicated in this case. He also submits that from perusal of the FIR, it is clear that the only role attributed to this petitioner is that of order giving. The petitioner has not made any assault. He further submits that a statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is languishing in judicial custody since 11.07.2025.

5. The application for bail is opposed by learned APP for the State.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned S.D.J.M., Danapur in connection with Shahpur P.S. Case No. 195 of 2025.
