5 29-06-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for
the offences punishable under Sections 173(2), 140(3) of the
Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita.

3. It is alleged this petitioner kidnapped the wife and
son of informant with oblique motive.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner
submits that petitioner is innocent and has committed no
offence. Upon search, wife of the informant was recovered and
in her statement, recorded under Section 183 BNSS, denied the
factum of kidnapping and stated that she left the house on her
own sweet will. Age of the victim is 32 years. Petitioner claims
clean antecedent.



5. Learned A.P.P. for the State vehemently opposed the bail application.

6. Considering statement of the victim recorded under Section 183 BNSS, this anticipatory bail is allowed and it is ordered that the above named petitioner in the event of his arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of eight weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nalanda in connection with Giriyak P. S. Case No. 455 of 2025, subject to condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita.
