ORAL ORDER

2 31-01-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioners seek bail in connection with Excise Case No. 1895 of 2025, arising out of Prohibition & Excise P.S. Bikramganj Case No. 294 of 2025, instituted for the offences punishable under Sections 30(a) and 30(c) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that total 130 liters of country made liquor was recovered from gallon in orchard. Petitioners were arrested on the spot.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the present case. No incriminating material has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioners. The petitioners have



got no concern with the alleged recovery of liquor. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submitted that the recovery has been made from Garden, which is an open place and is accessible to public at large. Chargesheet has been submitted. The petitioners are in custody since 07.12.2025 and have got no criminal antecedent. There is no compliance of Section 103 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioners.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and the period of custody undergone by the petitioners, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners.

7. Let the petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Excise Case No. 1895 of 2025, arising out of Prohibition & Excise P.S. Bikramganj Case No. 294 of 2025.
