ORAL ORDER

2 03-02-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Deodha PS Case No. 130 of 2025 instituted for the
offences under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise
Act and Sections 274, 275 & 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya
Sanhita, 2023.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that total 639
litres of liquor was recovered from five motorcycles.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that
the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case.
The name of the petitioner transpired in this case on the basis of
disclosure made by apprehended co-accused person. The
petitioner has got no concern with the alleged recovery of



liquor. It is submitted that petitioner has no concern with the motorcycles in question. The petitioner has three criminal antecedents. There is no compliance of Section 103 of the Bharatiya Nagarika Suraksha Sanhita, 2023. Learned counsel for the petitioner, therefore, contends that prima-facie no case is made out against the petitioner. Other co-accused has been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 16.12.2025, passed in Cr. Misc. No. 86679 of 2025.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.15,000/- (Fifteen thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Deodha PS Case No. 130 of 2025, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarika Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
