ORAL ORDER

2 09-03-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Bhagwan Bazar P.S. Case No. 596 of 2025 instituted for the offences under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 118, 109, 351(1), 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

3. Prosecution case, in short, is that three accused persons including the petitioner assaulted the son of the informant by knife.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that general and omnibus allegation has been made against the petitioner. No



specific overt act is alleged against the petitioner. Learned counsel further submitted that the injury is simple in nature caused by hard blunt substance which falsifies the prosecution case. He further submitted that charge-sheet has already been submitted against the petitioner. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 28.10.2025 and has one criminal antecedent.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, charge-sheet already being submitted as also the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Bhagwan Bazar P.S. Case No. 596 of 2025, subject to the following conditions:

(I) One of the bailors shall be own/close member of the family of the petitioner.

(II) The petitioner shall appear on each and every date fixed at the trial. In case of default in such appearance on two



consecutive dates, the Trial Court will have liberty to cancel the
bail bonds of the petitioner.
