2. The present matter has been preferred for:



“invoking the inherent jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court for initiating contempt of Court proceeding against the Opposite Parties for deliberate and willful violation and non-compliance of the order dated 20-02-2020 passed by Hon'ble Mr Justice Anil Kumar Upadhyay in C.W.J.C. No. 11117 OF 2018 whereby and whereunder the order of termination of the petitioner dated 22-12-2018 was quashed and the writ petition was disposed of with a direction to Opposite Party No. 8, The Director, Primary Education to take appropriate decision with regard to claim of the petitioner as to reinstatement and back wages for illegal termination of the petitioner and it was further observed that necessary fresh direction in this regard must be taken by the Director, Primary Education, Bihar within a maximum period of 45 days from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the sole petitioner is no more, and as such, the file has to be consigned.

4. Learned APP for the State states that the contempt order stands complied.

5. Taking note of the submission put forwarded by the parties, M.J.C No. 735 of 2021 is disposed of.
