Jamo Bazar P.S. Case No. 82 of 2017.

02. The petitioner approached this Court seeking

direction to the respondent authorities to discharge their

obligation to investigate the case in proper and fair manner in

the aforementioned P.S. case number. If the investigation has



completed, the matter has become infructuous after filing of the charge sheet. Therefore, the writ does not remain maintainable.

03. If the petitioner has still any grievance, the petitioner has got remedy under Section 173(8) CrPC/193(9) BNSS to approach the trial court where the charge sheet has been filed.

04. Accordingly, finding no cause of action in the present writ petition, the same is disposed of.
