2. The present petition has been preferred for the following relief(s):

due to the non-compliance of order dated
06/05/2025 passed in C.W.J.C No. 16580 of 2017
Smt. Krishna Jha and 3 others petitioner Vs The

A show cause has come on behalf of the opposite party and Mr. Viveka Nand Singh, learned State counsel has taken this Court to paragraphs 7 and 8 to submit that a decision was taken by the District Land Acquisition Officer, Patna for making payment amongst other to the petitioner and paragraph 8 shows that a sum of Rs. 21,45,864 has been handed over to the petitioner for her acquired land on 16.01.2026.
