2 24-02-2026 Heard the parties.

2. The petitioner is named in the F.I.R. and apprehending his arrest in connection with Hilsa P.S. Case No. 191 of 2025 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 103(1) and 3(5) of the BNS and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

3. As per FIR, petitioner along with other co-accused persons alleged to commit murder of the husband of the informant, where occurrence alleged to be arising out of land dispute.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner that informant is the eye-witness of the occurrence, who is the wife of the deceased and also who authored the FIR. It is submitted that from the FIR it can be gathered safely that allegation of firing is not available against this petitioner rather available against five named co-accused persons. It is also submitted that there is no allegation *qua* any overt act against this



petitioner and as this petitioner was passing on motorcycle near to the place of occurrence co-incidentally, he was implicated falsely with the present case. While concluding argument it is submitted that petitioner found involved in three more cases, where he is on bail.

5. Learned APP opposes the prayer of bail.

6. In view of aforesaid factual and legal submission and by taking note of fact as allegation *qua* firing is not available against this petitioner, rather same is available against named co-accused persons, accordingly petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks, is directed to be released on bail, furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned ACJM, Nalanda/concerned Court, where the case is pending in connection with Hilsa P.S. Case No. 191 of 2025, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C/ Section 482(2) of BNSS.
