Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. The present writ application in the form of a Public
Interest Litigation has been preferred by the petitioner for the
following reliefs:-

3. Upon perusal of record, it appears that the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 29.12.2023 (Annexure-P/2 to the present writ application) before Respondent No. 5, which is still pending consideration.

Considering the same, Respondent No. 5 is directed to consider and dispose of the petitioner's representation by passing a reasoned and speaking order, in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to all the stakeholders, preferably within a period of 8 weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.

5. With the aforesaid observations and directions, the present writ application stands disposed of.
