18.12.2025 in Paliganj P.S. Case no. 601 of

*(ii) for issuance of an appropriate writ,  
order or direction commanding the  
respondent authorities to forthwith release  
the petitioner's vehicle, which is lying seized,  
during the pendency of the present writ  
petition, on such terms and conditions as  
this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper;  
(iii) for issuance of any other writ, order or  
direction for which the petitioner may be  
found entitled in the facts and circumstances  
of the case;*

notice was granted to remove the defect(s) and the order was
