2 11-03-2026 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 109,
115(2), 118(1), 117(2), 132, 190, 191(2), 191(3), 196, 299 of the
B.N.S.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
the petitioner has antecedent of one case, in which he is on bail.
It is next submitted that informant alleges that on orders of
S.D.O., the informant along with police force reached village-
Bela, where a law and order situation had arisen, further, 36
named accused persons along with 30-40 unknown accused
created ruckus and assaulted the force leading to injuries.



4. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the instant case by the informant. It is next submitted that from perusal of the allegation as alleged in the FIR, it would manifest that allegation of assault is general and omnibus in nature.

5. Learned A.P.P. opposes the anticipatory bail application.

6. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner, above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender within a period of six weeks, is directed to be released on anticipatory bail on his furnishing bail-bonds in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Gurua P. S. Case No.303 of 2025, subject to the conditions laid down under Section 482(2) of the B.N.S.S.
