3 09-04-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, informant
and the State.

2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for
the offences punishable under Sections 103(1), 3(5) of the
Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita.

3. As per prosecution case, it is alleged that this
petitioner, along with other accused persons, committed murder
of the husband of informant.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. From
bare perusal of the F.I.R. it is apparent that there is no eye
witness to the occurrence and only suspicion has been raised
against this petitioner only on the ground of prior dispute. It is



further submitted that during investigation, one Sone Lal Sah was apprehended and he, in his confessional statement, confessed that he committed the alleged offence and he has not named this petitioner. During investigation, no material has come to suggest the complicity of this petitioner in the alleged offence. Similarly situated co-accused, namely, Abhiram Kumar has already been granted anticipatory bail by this Court *vide* order dated 17.03.2026 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 89942 of 2025. Petitioner claims clean antecedent.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State as well as learned counsel for the informant vehemently opposed the bail application.

6. Considering backdrop of the case, nature of accusation and clean antecedent, this anticipatory bail is allowed and it is ordered that let the above named petitioner in the event of his arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of eight weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, East Champaran, Motihari in connection with Patahi P. S. Case No. 195 of 2024, subject to condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha
