petitioner and learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in connection with Bahadurganj P.S. Case No. 415 of 2025 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 74, 351(2), 352 and 3(5) of BNS.

3. As per the allegation made in the F.I.R., all the accused persons including the petitioner assaulted the informant and his wife causing them injury on vital part of the body.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has committed no offence as alleged in the F.I.R. There is case and counter case between the parties. The petitioner might have caused some injury on the person of the informant and his wife in his self defence without any intention. The petitioner has clean antecedent.



5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

6. Having heard the rival submissions made on behalf of the parties, as well as, having perused the allegation made in the F.I.R., the petitioner had entered in fierce fight and may have caused injury in his self defence, the petitioner appears to have, *prima facie*, made out a case to be released on pre-arrest bail.

7. The petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on pre-arrest bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Kishanganj in connection with Bahadurganj P.S. Case No. 415 of 2025, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C / 482(2) BNSS.

8. The District Court is directed to verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioner and if it is found that the petitioner is involved in some other cases as what has been stated in Para-3 of the bail petition, this order will automatically lose its force.

9. The bail application stands disposed of.
