learned APP for the State.

2. The instant application for anticipatory bail has been filed by the petitioner apprehending his arrest in connection with GRP Rail Barh P.S. Case no. 05 of 2025 instituted for the offence under Sections 191(1), 191(2), 126(2), 115(2), 125, 352, 3(5) of the B.N.S., 2023, Sections 27 of the Arms Act and Sections 145 and 147 of the Railway Act.

3. The case of the prosecution, in short, is that two groups of the boys were having scuffle between them, and they were also making firing. It is alleged that the petitioner and one Veeru Kumar were making firing.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has



committed no offence. He has falsely been implicated in this case. He also submits that it is not disclosed in the FIR as to who has disclosed the name of this petitioner to the informant. He further submits that a statement has been made in para-3 of this petition that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and no one has received any injury.

5. In contra, learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer of bail of the petitioner.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The petitioner is directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of his arrest or surrender in connection with GRP Rail Barh P.S. Case No. 05 of 2025, he will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, Railway, Patna subject to the conditions as laid down under section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
