2 28-04-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 351(2), 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

3. As per prosecution case, on 04.06.2025 at about 5:50 PM, when informant was going to the market, he received information from his nephew that some people are assaulting his son near Brahmsthan and when he reached at the place of occurrence, he saw that all the F.I.R. named accused persons, including this petitioner, were assaulting his son and were making indiscriminate firing.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. On account



of previous enmity, quarrel took place between the parties in which both sides sustained injuries. Case and counter case. Allegation of assault is general and omnibus and there is no specific allegation of overt act against the petitioner. Injury allegedly caused by this petitioner is simple in nature.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State vehemently opposed the bail application.

6. Considering backdrop of the case, nature of accusation and injury, this anticipatory bail is allowed and it is ordered that let the above named petitioner in the event of his arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of eight weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Bhojpur at Ara in connection with Bihiya P. S. Case No. 200 of 2025, subject to condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
