ORAL ORDER

2 25-02-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Bidupur PS Case No. 692 of 2025 instituted for the offences
under Section/s 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act
and Sections 274 & 275 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that 1500 liters
country made liquor was recovered from Tata vehicle.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the
present case. No incriminating material has been recovered from
the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has got
no concern with the alleged recovery of liquor. It is submitted



that name of the petitioner has surfaced in this case on the disclosure made by apprehended co-accused person, who stated that petitioner is the associate in the offence. Petitioner is neither the driver nor the owner of the vehicle in question. The petitioner is in custody since 22.01.2026 and has got three criminal antecedent/s. There is no compliance of Section 103 of the BNSS, 2023. Other co-accused has been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 27-01-2026, passed in Cr. Misc. No. 4367 of 2026.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.15,000/- (Fifteen thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Bidupur PS Case No. 692 of 2025, subject to the following conditions:

(I) One of the bailors shall be own/close member of the family of the petitioner.

(II) The petitioner shall appear on each and every date



fixed at the trial. In case of default in such appearance on two consecutive dates, the Trial Court will have liberty to cancel the bail bonds of the petitioner.
