3 25-03-2026 The present writ application has been filed for the following reliefs:

“1. That this writ application is being filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of "Mandamus" for commanding the respondents to include the petitioner firm in the panel of the



selected agencies pursuant to the tender process for empanelment of agencies for Mass Management Services for Government Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) in the State of Bihar; as the petitioner has duly submitted all requisite qualifications including work experience, net worth certificate and other related documents within the time granted, and further since similarly situated persons have been selected by the respondent authority.

1/A For issuance of any other writ/writs, order/orders, direction/directions for which the petitioner is found entitled to.”

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already approached Respondent No. 2 by filing a representation bearing Letter No. 185 dated 12.02.2026, which is still pending consideration.

3. Having regard to the nature of the relief sought and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, Respondent No. 2 is directed to consider the representation of the petitioner and pass a reasoned and speaking order in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to all the stakeholders.

4. Accordingly, with the aforesaid observation, the present writ application stands disposed of.
