Learned counsel representing the Municipal Corporation, Sasaram with the help of the Annexure 4/C to the show cause submit that Memo No. 2312 dated 19.06.2026 has been passed by the Municipal Commissioner allowing the parties to put up their respective (Gumti) in the campus of the old bus stand and so far as the claim regarding the earlier site is concerned, it touches the Judges Colony boundary which is not an appropriate place on security point of view.

4. Granting liberty to the petitioners if they so want to agitate the matter, the MJC No. 551 of 2026 is disposed of.
