4 13-03-2026 Perused the Letter No. 159 dated 10.02.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Banka, along with Memo No. 188 of 2026 dated 09.02.2026 of the Sub-Inspector of Police, Shambhuganj Police Station, Banka, wherein it is indicated that during the enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Nandni Devi, is dead.
