learned counsel for the State.

2. This is the 2<sup>nd</sup> attempt of the petitioner seeking bail  
in connection with Basopatti P.S. Case No. 42 of 2025  
registered for the offence under Sections 179, 180 and 3(5) of  
the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

3. Earlier the bail application of the petitioner was  
rejected on 03.09.2025 in Cr. Misc. No. 41884 of 2025 which  
reads as follows:-

Heard the learned counsel for the  
petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection  
with Basopatti P.S. Case No. 42 of 2025 registered for the  
offence under Sections 179, 180, 3(5) of the BNS.

3. As per the prosecution case, the  
petitioner is accused of dealing in fake currency as well  
as foreign currency.

4. The petitioner is in custody since



3.3.2025.

5. Considering the nature of allegation levelled against the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this application is dismissed.

5. The petitioner has failed to disclose his criminal antecedents in paragraph no. 3 of the bail petition. This Court has observed that, in a large number of cases, criminals antecedents are being brought on record through supplementary affidavits, which is not permissible. If the accused has any criminal antecedents, the same must be clearly stated in the main bail petition itself and not introduced later by way of a supplementary affidavit.

6. In these circumstances, this application is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh bail application as per the Patna High Court Rules.
