2 24-03-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection Bahera P.S.
Case No. 15 of 2026 registered for the offence punishable under
Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. There is recovery of 216 liters of illicit liquor. The
petitioner is in jail since 21.01.2026 and he claims clean
antecedent.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is ready to donate Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five
Thousand Only) in some charitable organization without
accepting his guilt.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed
the prayer of the petitioner.



6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submission of learned counsel for the petitioner, this application for regular bail is allowed.

7. Accordingly, let the petitioner above named be released on bail, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned concerned Court below in connection with Bahera P.S. Case No. 15 of 2026 subject to the condition that:-

(I). The petitioner shall deposit an amount of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only) in Ramakrishna Math, Village Jharha (near Matua Pahar), P.O. Gurua, Dist. Gaya, Bihar 824205, and produce the receipt of the same before the Court below. The bail bonds of the petitioner shall be accepted after verifying the genuineness of the receipt produced by the petitioner.

(ii). The petitioner is directed to mark his attendance at Chatra Police Station, Jharkhand on every Sunday of each month. Failure to do so, will result in cancellation of bail bond of the petitioner.

8. Let a copy of this order be communicated to the Superintendent of Police, Chatra through FAX or e-mail for



immediate compliance.
